REPERTOIRE AND RESOURCES FOR THE PARISH MUSICIAN – a seminar presented by the

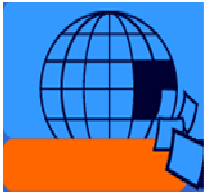
