Every year on this date the world honours the courage, resilience and strength of refugees who are forced to flee their homeland under threat of persecution, conflict and violence. Attention is focused not only on the plight of refugees and the causes of their exile, but also on the determination and will to survive and on the contributions they make to their host communities.
