Fr John Wakeling Update Thank you for your support at this time. I had scans on 14 Jan and saw the oncologist on 18 Jan. The results showed that the tumors in the brain and the lung are clear, but, there is some growth in the spots in the adrenal glands. The oncologist has told me that they are not life threatening at this stage, that we could sit and watch or we could take the aggressive course and have chemo. I have decided to undergo the chemo route which will begin on February 1. Will keep you all informed as we go along. Thanks again, John Wakeling
